Tip of the Month

- ❖ *Wet weather shooting! If your gun gets wet at the range, it is necessary to dry it off before you put it in the car to go home. However, it is not a good idea to put a gun that has been very wet into a case like a fur-lined sleeve to go home. There will be moisture that you cannot get out of the gun, and it will transfer to the inside of the sleeve. The sleeve will then cause rust on the gun the next time you use it. So leave the gun in parts out of the sleeve until you have had a chance to really dry it out at home.*
